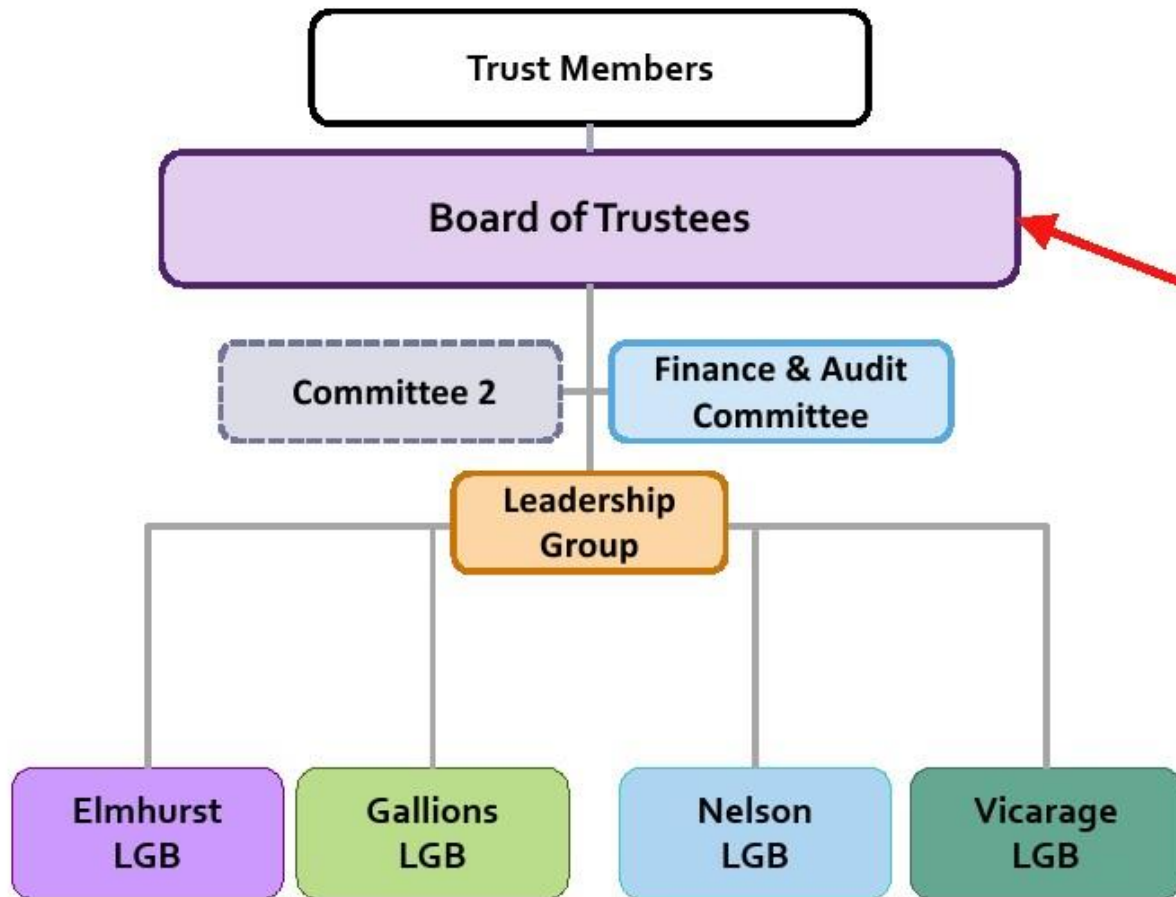

8 key roles

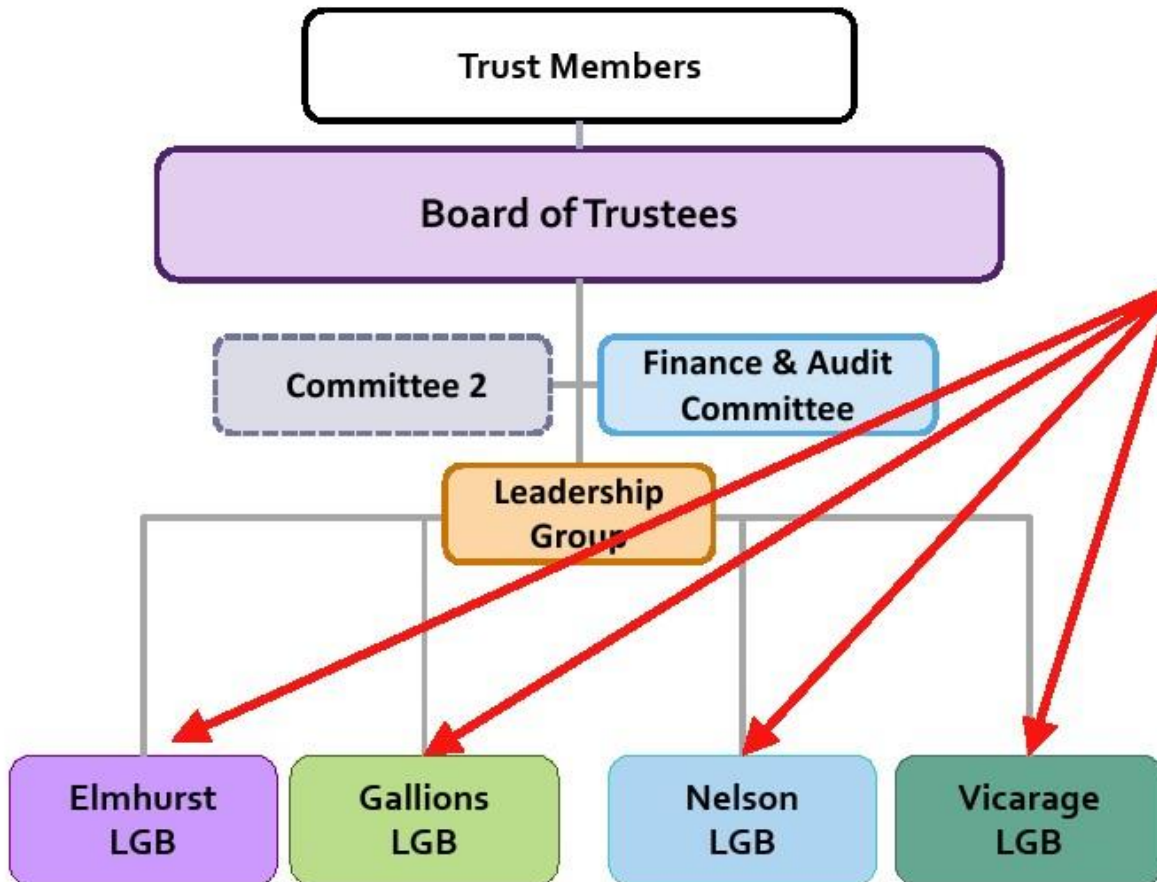

- Interface with parents and community

Trust principles of governance: Trustees

- DfE clear guidance that Trustees need have a broad range of expertise and skills. DfE approves the list of founding Trustees.
- Primary requirement to ensure Trustees have expertise in :
 - Educational Standards & Performance
 - Finance & Accountancy
 - HR & Employment
 - Child Well-being & Safety
 - Compliance & Legal Affairs
 - Property, capital projects and H&S
 - Strategy & Business Management
 - Public Administration & Governance
- Secondary requirement to have at least one Trustee from each founding school's governing body if possible.
- CEO can be a Trustee but not other Headteachers or members of staff.
